It seems like we were just returning from our trip in South Africa in January-February 2020 with such enthusiasm knowing we had confirmation that the ministry to and for persons with disabilities was to be our next "season" of ministry. A few months later it has been difficult to remember what we did accomplish while in South Africa. It was only when we had a request for our assistance and insight on starting a disability ministry that we were able to look with fresh eyes and see what did come from that trip. We started some

South Africa. In addition; we could see how we can go about picking up the ministry when we are able to return to South Africa. It was our greatest joy when Empowered Beyond Limits and our partners were able to extend the love and compassion of Christ to Edmund. When we last saw Edmund, he had a wheelchair that was quite nice but did not serve him well, causing pain and other issues. Edmund was also in need of warm clothes, socks and something to cover his feet. Through the assistance of our partners in South Africa and their resources, Edmund now has a new wheelchair, he was able to receive some warm clothes, something for his feet for winter and food and other necessities. In addition; he has been able to get to town and Church with Pastor Leon.

Pastor Leon has also been helping Edmund in getting all of the necessary paperwork submitted so he can return to Zimbabwe then he can re-enter South Africa and be able to work and whatever else God has in store for him. Our last update from Pastor Leon was that the adults and children with disabilities who were living at Christina's Group home went back to their family homes during the Covid shutdown. They have not yet been allowed to return to the group home. However; those living at the hospice/long-term care home were allowed to remain. Our partners in ministry "Reaching a Generation" have been able to provide the Hospice Center with food during this time.

Our final day in South Africa God seemed to continue to connect us with the people who could identify with us, as parents of a daughter with a disability. One such

encounter was with a young man, Thomie, who assisted us through the Johannesburg SA airport. He told us about his daughter with special needs. We have been able to keep in communication with him since we have been home. He was laid off at the airport when Covid hit and all international flights cancelled. He has had some very difficult times through these past months. We just received word he has just recently been called back to work and has a
