Pastor Leon was able to assist Edmund with getting his Visa and return to Zimbabwe to be with his family. Through the generous donations of those who have partnered with us, Empowered Beyond Limits was able to provide the funds to make this happen. Pastor Leon had continued to work with us until December 2020.

We recently spoke with Christina and she provided us with exciting updates of her work with a wide range of ages of persons with and without disabilities. Christina informed us that all the residents from both group homes were able to remain through the COVID lockdown where they have remained safe, healthy and well cared for. Christina's Home was able to build remarkable tiny houses that will be the home for up to 8 people per tiny home. This new addition of assisted living quarters provides shelter for more vulnerable adults over 65 years of age.
