May 5th we will be celebrating our first year on the Mission Field here in South Africa. It being a rollercoaster year for us as a family is an understatement. Yet in and through it, God has been so amazing in confirming and reconfirming we are exactly where He wants us to be doing what He has called us to do. We ended 2023 and started of 2024 with Faith in a Pretoria Hospital with Bacterial Meningitis and a couple of other infections. She stayed from Christmas Eve through the end of January. Though she is much better she needs healing of brain damage. She tells us; "I miss me". So, your prayers continue to be very much appreciated.





Even with Faith in the Hospital there was a highlight in the middle of it. EBL and team were able to get Ramy, and her sister Portia, down to Pretoria to be fitted for her specialized Wheelchair. Joel was able to go right over to CE Mobility and be a part of what started 7 months ago. They were even able to come by and visit Faith and we're hoping to see Ramy in her chair sometime in May. Ramy told us she is going to church as soon as she gets her chair.

Vanessa is a little 9-year-old girl born with Spina Bifida. She has had an adult wheelchair she used as needed but she is usually on her hands and knees to move around. She had not been able to start school, even at a local "special" school, due to her needing help with toileting.



We visited with Vanessa during the Easter Holiday and she was so very happy and ready to go back to school.

She had to start in kindergarten, and quickly transitioned to 1st grade work. After the holiday she started 2nd grade with a new Vanessa-sized wheelchair from Mokopane

Hospital!


